Comparison of key features (end-users)

▪ **Old Supplier Portal** — on-premise solution

• **End-User:**

- Outdated look
- Design limits of on-premise solution (“box-like formatting”)
- Rotating banner could not be paused
- Mobile viewing overlapped some content

▪ **New Supplier Portal** - cloud-based solution

• **End-User:**

- Visually-appealing look (modern website)
- HTML-based for greater screen functionality
- Rotating banner with greater control to start/stop, directional arrows
- Improved mobile viewing for cell phones and tablets
- Improved and more accurate search functionality

Comparison of key features (content owners)

▪ **Old Supplier Portal** – on-premise solution

• **Content Owners:**

- Content managed by the site administrators only (configurable to content owners, but more difficult to set up)
- Approvals through separate product workflows

▪ **New Supplier Portal** - cloud-based solution

• **Content Owners:**

- HTML-based content (rather than SharePoint web parts for greater use of the screen)
- Automatic “lock icon” display to indicate pages / files located on the secure portion of the Portal
- Improvement in anchor links (“links on areas on same page”)

Comparison of key features (administration)

▪ **Old Supplier Portal** – on-premise solution

• **Administration:**

- A more expensive solution due to Microsoft licensing
- Acceptable level of content security
- More difficult content management and content approval process
- Group-based security

▪ **New Supplier Portal** - cloud-based solution

• **Administration:**

- Less expensive platform (no licensing fees)
- Enhanced, page-level and role-based security
- Easier and more flexible content management
- Role-based security
